





Comparative Total Revenue/Income, CY 2016 - 2018



Comparative Internal Revenue Allotment, CY 2016 - 2018




Comparative Local Revenue/Income, CY 2016 - 2018




Comparative City Total Expenditures, CY 2016 - 2018






Comparative City Maintenance and Other Operating Expense (MOOE), CY 2016 - 2018
